FEP is currently providing the following programs for the members of the Foundation:

- Women's Group Personal Development: We are currently serving 2 'Generations' of women, with another group commencing in the late Fall. We are currently serving just over 30
- Men's Individual and Group Personal Development Program: A small group of 3 men, but we hope to continue to grow this much needed program.
- Adolescence Personal Development Group: Our children are getting older! We now have a group of our older children in an adolescence group. They work on their personal development as well as serving the community.
- Children Personal Development Group: 3 new groups are being added Fall 2016. Now programming will be available to all children ages 6+ from Generation14 & Generation15
- Individual, Couple's and Family therapy: We are so thrilled to have our psychologist, Teresa Manzano, as a full time staff member to meet the needs of all the Personal Development Programs and Therapeutic Services. What a blessing to FEP!
- English Training for Women, Men and Children: Generation14 members participate in English Training, with the opportunity being extended to Generation 15 soon. A special welcome to Vanessa ... our wonderful English Teacher. As well as a heartfelt THANK YOU to Colleen and Wally Mah from Saskatoon, SK for their donation for this year's English Program
- Children's Reading Group: Local volunteer Sandra has taken over the weekly reading club to encourage and support the habit and hobby of reading for enjoyment. This will be a great asset in the educational development of our FEP children
